
Whitney Aragaki, PhD

With a Bachelor of Arts in biology from Swarthmore College and a Master of Science in Tropical Conservation Biology and Environmental Science from the University of Hawai'i at Hilo, Aragaki earned a Doctor of Philosophy in curriculum and instruction at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa College of Education. Recognized as the 2022 Hawai'i State Teacher of the Year and a National Teacher of the Year Finalist, Aragaki holds National Board Certification in Adolescence and Young Adulthood Mathematics and has been a two-time state finalist for the Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching. In 2023, she was selected as part of the inaugural class of Obama Foundation Leaders USA.
